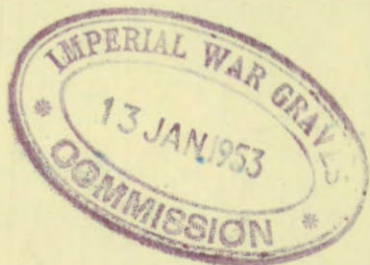
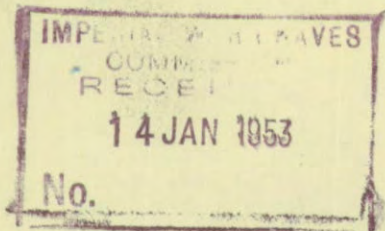

Dear Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 12th. January, the grave of the late 4896 Gunner R. Moreton, 'D' Battery, 174th. Brigade, Royal Field Artillery, date of death 29th. November, 1917, is in Vlamertinghe New Military Cemetery, Belgium, Plot IX., Row A., Grave No. 12.

This cemetery is about $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles south of the station at Vlamertinghe on the road to Ouderdom. The nearest convenient large centre is Ypres, Belgium, and if you should be there and in need of further advice this could be obtained at the Commission's Branch office, No. 31. Rue d'Elverdinghe.

I regret that the Commission do not arrange visits neither are they aware of any organised trips, but any reliable travel agency would be able to advise you as to how best to reach Ypres.
