
In reply to your letter dated 3rd May, I can inform you that the late Lance Bombardier S.J. Coventry, 90416, Royal Garrison Artillery, is buried in Sebourg British Cemetery, France, the particulars of his grave being Row B, Grave 9.

Sebourg is a village in the Department Nord, six miles east of the town of Valkenciennes, very close to the Belgian frontier. The British Cemetery is on the east side of the village, 200 yards north of the road to Roisin.

The Cemetery is quite small and there should not be any difficulty in finding a particular grave. It is also open at all times.

According to this Commission's records Lance Bombardier Coventry lost his life on 5th November 1918, aged 37.
