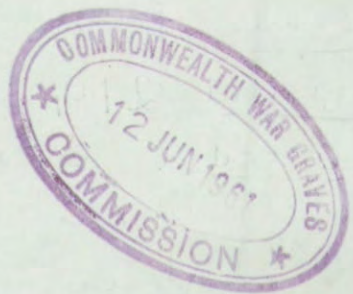



Dear Mrs. Read,

In reply to your letter dated 10th June, I can confirm that Gunner F.W.M. Baker, 110089, Royal Garrison Artillery, is buried in Coxyde Military Cemetery, Belgium. The particulars of his grave are Plot 1, Row E, Grave 58.

The village of Coxyde is 16 miles south-west of Ostend and $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles inland from the seaside village of Coxyde-Bains. The Military Cemetery which is open at all times is a quarter of a mile west of the village of Coxyde on the road to La Panne. A register, containing a plan, is available on the spot.
