aged 38 years.

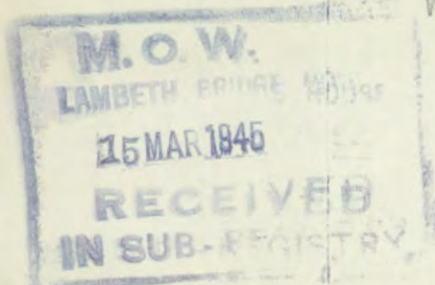
